Our learning in Nursery

Topic

This term our topic will be 'All About Me', we will be thinking about what makes us unique and special and reading lots of lovely stories to support this learning. We will be covering the topics of homes, emotions, our bodies, strengths and friendships. Each week celebrating our learning with crafts and enhancements to our learning environments. We will be talking about who lives in our home next week and would really love you to send in some close family photos to create our nursery family album, this allows the children to take a peek in the shared book if they are missing Mummy, Daddy or siblings.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Children are not ready to learn until they feel happy and safe and so this area of development is a huge priority for us, particularly in our first term. We have spent lots of time learning where everything is and what to do if we need help. We have had some wonderful group discussions and the class helped to create their own charter of actions to keep our environment filled with kindness and respect. We then gave it a thumbs up with some finger painting.

Throughout this term we will have regular carpet times on how to label and support our own emotions and well-being. In nursery we will be using a supportive strategy called the Zones of Regulation and we will share some information with parents about this along the way.

Communication and Language

In nursery we use a number of ways to help build our communication, this week we have introduced our 'drawing disco'. The children take part in a group discussion about a topic and then we use our special grown up books to draw a picture from the topic, using music to get our creativity flowing! We have also already started our Helicopter Stories, one of the children's absolute favourite parts of the week. We sit with an individual child and scribe their own story, in their own words, then the class all share in acting out the story, we will share these with you at the end of the year, we get some absolute crackers! I hope you are ready to hear a lot about princesses, dragons and the occasional flamingo! Our learning in Reception

Topic

This term, our topic is 'All About Me'. We have started the term collaborating what we want our class rules to be, and what we think is important in school.
